THE GRAND VALLEY LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAM

What is the charge and what do I get for the charge?

There is a \$12.00 non refundable annual registration fee, this will cover your membership to US Figure Skating (USFS).

Members of USFS also receive the following benefits:

- Subscription to SKATING magazine
- Individually numbered membership card
- Coverage under U.S. Figure Skating's sports accident insurance policy

ALL SKATERS IN THE GRAND VALLEY LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAM MUST BE MEMBERS OF USFS.

*The learn to skate series is \$50.00 for a 6 week course, you will get skate rental, 6 weeks of instruction on and off the ice from registered USFS instructors, you will also get free access to the learn to skate practice ice. You will also be able to skate during the Saturday and Sunday figure ice time at a reduced rate.

What do I need?

For first timers or for pros you always want to dress in layers. As a student warms up they can dress down as they so choose. You will need thick warm socks to keep your feet warm. For your legs- leggings, thermals, and sweats or jeans underneath a snow suit or snow pants. A long sleeve shirt, thermals, etc., a sweater and a ski jacket for your upper body. Gloves (waterproof) are suggested for anyone entering the ice. With this being an outdoor rink you will want a hat, preferably water proof. You'll want some sunglasses, even some sunscreen on those warmer days. If you have your own skates you'll want to bring them as well. We do have some to borrow if you don't have your own. Helmets are recommended until you feel comfortable on the ice. We do not provide helmets so you'll need to bring your own.

SNOWPLOW GROUPS- It is mandatory for this group to wear gloves & helmets. We do not provide helmets but a bicycle helmet works great. Having a second set of gloves is also a good idea. If little kids get cold, they are no longer having fun and won't want to participate. Remember this when dressing them.

What to expect?

On your first day you may spend more time off the ice than on, learning safety procedures, rules, and also getting stable on your feet first. Once we are on the ice the instructors will take role while the kids "warm up". At that time depending on your level you will begin working on the skills assigned to that class. The last day of class is testing/ fun day. We will let the students know what level they need to move up to, and then work on the skills they have learned and just have some fun. If the participant is ready to move up a level, we will not hold them back they will automatically graduate the class they have signed up for and move on to the next level.

SNOWPLOW GROUPS - All kids learn at different rates. Our first day of class is usually spent off the ice just learning to balance on these itty bitty blades. Then if time allows we take the kids on the ice. Once your child moves through the snowplow classes they will then register into the basic 8's courses.

RULES

If you have questions regarding the classes arrange a time to meet with the instructor, DO NOT INTERRUPT a class at any time.

PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE ICE AT ANY TIME. We are trained professionals, if there is a reason for you to be with your child we will bring them to you or take you to them.

One makeup per session is allowed, they can attend the same week on a different day or the following week on a different day. Refunds WILL NOT BE GIVEN for makeup classes.

You being a parent or participant are not allowed to criticize the staff including but not limited to instructors, assistants, directors, volunteers, etc.

As a parent or participant you will not belittle, degrade, or criticize participants, instructors or parents in the program.

As a parent or participant- you are not a coach do not attempt to teach skills to others.

As a parent, do not "coach" your child, if your child is struggling with a skill, there are private instructors available to work individually with that child.

As a parent or participant cussing, hitting, kicking, biting, pushing, etc. will not be tolerated. Any form of this behavior is grounds for dismissal from the premises and the program without a refund.

Parents may take pictures on the first and last day of class, otherwise it disrupts the classes in session.

DO NOT AT ANYTIME block the entranceways on or off the ice.

If a participant is misbehaving in class or is disrupting the class they may be asked to leave the ice for a "timeout". If the behavior does not stop, a meeting will be needed with the participant and parents/guardians before the child can resume in classes. If the behavior continues in the future, they may be dismissed from the course without a refund.

There will be assistant coaches on the ice, they are not permitted to answer questions regarding the classes and participants. They are there to assist, save your questions for the instructors of the class, not during class times 😊!
